The current school term promises to be a very busy one for the VOC, as you can see from our tentative trip schedule. Participation is what makes each trip a success and so we encourage you to go on as many trips as is academically feasible.

In case you have been out of touch, here is a brief update on club activities. Construction of the Mt. Brew cabin was completed by volunteer club members in September, and the cabin is ready for the enjoyment of the public. We are currently applying for leases to cabin sites in the Callaghan Lake and Overseer areas, and will hopefully be needing your help for their construction this summer. A "Guide to Ski-touring in the Lower Coast Range (Squamish-Pemberton Range)", and a new edition of the VOC songbook are ready for publication, and will be available to the public in the next month. Coming up on Fri. Jan. 28 is the annual Christmas Reunion Party. Slides of the various Christmas trips will be shown, so this event is of interest primarily to Christmas trip participants. However, other club members are welcome to attend. This year's banquet will be held March 25 at the Faculty Club, and will include dinner, dancing, and a presentation. Journals will be given out at the banquet, and as this year's is our 25th anniversary edition, the journal committee is working hard to make it something special. We urge you to write articles to contribute to its success.

Information about upcoming trips and social events is available at VOC general meetings, held on Wednesdays at 12:30 pm in Chemistry 150, and sign-up sheets are posted on the bulletin board in the Clubroom (basement of SUB beside the games room).

Most Club outings in winter are on skis; trips range in difficulty from day trips suitable for beginners to multi-day glacier tours. Select a trip suitable for yourself then sign up in the clubroom or, if you have any questions, contact the trip's coordinator.

The club also offers instruction in outdoor activities. This term we are scheduling an avalanche course taught by a licenced mountain guide, a cross-country ski school at Manning Park, and a rock climbing school in late March.

In April, if you have a few days between exams, the Club's annual Sphinx ski camp on Garibaldi Lake is just what you need. The club flies the food into Sphinx Cabin, so you can ski in with a light pack and then stay as long as you like, skiing up peaks or simply basking in the spring sunshine.

The trip list presented here is by no means complete. If there are any trips you'd like to organize yourself, it's as simple as putting up a trip sheet in the clubroom.
